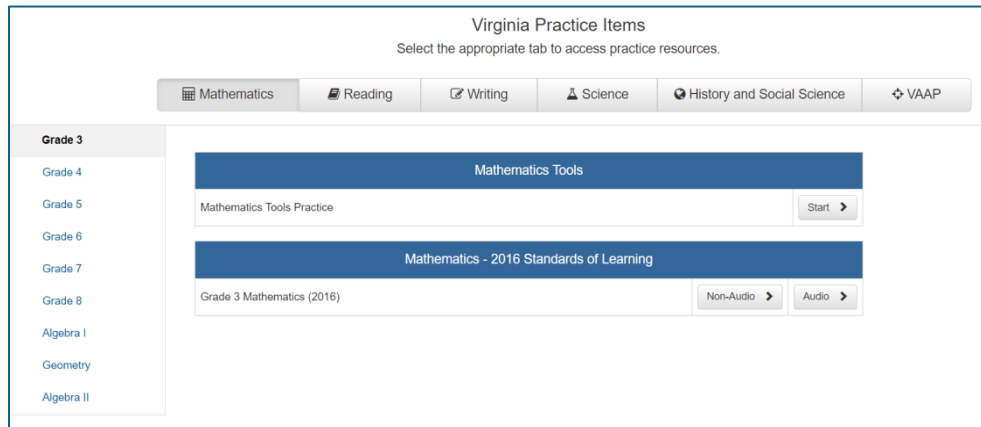


Accessing SOL Practice Items

Accessing Online (Can Be Done from a Personal Computer or iPad or From a School Laptop)

1. Go to <https://download.pearsonaccessnext.com/virginia/va-practicetest.html?links=1>



2. Click on the correct grade level on the left side.
3. Click on the correct subject tab at the top.
 - a. 3rd grade – reading & math
 - b. 4th grade – reading, math, & history and social science
 - c. 5th grade – reading (including integrated reading and writing), math, & science
4. Click on the “non-audio” button to start the practice test. If your child has an IEP accommodation that allows them to listen to the test, click the “audio” button instead.
5. Practice tests do not show students whether they have answered correctly or provide the correct answers.

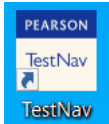
Accessing Through the TestNav App (Only on School Laptops)

1. To use the TestNav app, students will have to log into their laptops with the following login instead of their normal login.

username: solaves
password: online

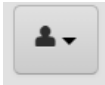


2. Double click the TestNav app on the desktop.



3. If TestNav opens and does not say “Virginia” on the screen, you will have to change to Virginia by

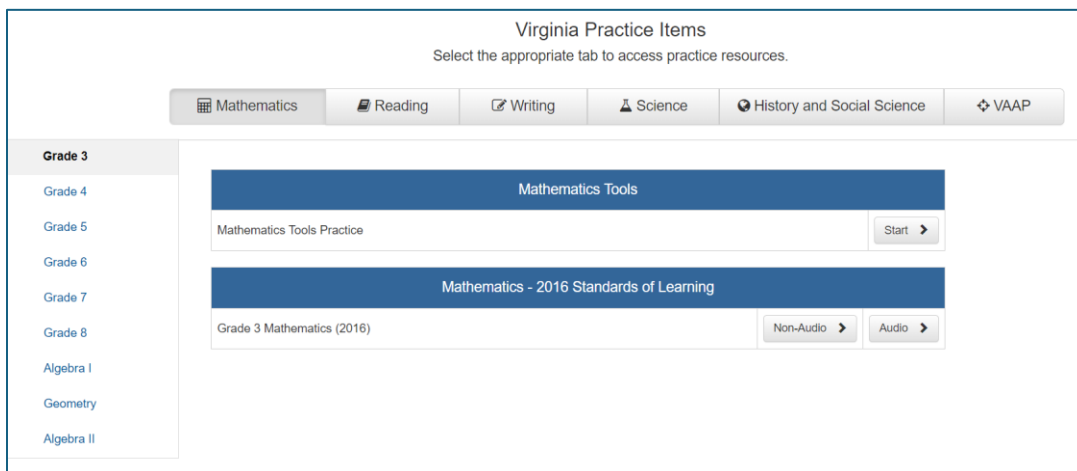
- a. In the top right corner, click on the person icon.



- b. Click on “Choose a different customer.”
- c. Click on “Virginia.”

4. To access the practice item for the SOL, click on the “practice items” link under the log in boxes.

5. Click on the correct grade level on the left side.



6. Click on the correct subject tab at the top.
